Please call in students absence before 10:00 am the same day your student is home ill or you will get an automated call out generated from the District Office after 10:00 am informing you that your child is not at school.

Free or Reduced Lunch applications are available in our school office, on-line or in the Annual Student Information Update (Re-enrollment) system. The form needs to be completed as soon as possible. New applications will be processed as soon as possible, and a letter will be sent to you advising the children's status once it has been processed.

Simple steps can protect everyone during flu season

The cold and flu season has begun! To help keep all of our CUSD students and families healthy, please keep the following healthy habits in mind:

- Just like we do at school, encourage your child to frequently wash his or her hands, cover coughs and sneezes, and avoid sharing food or drinks with others.
- Don't send your child to school if he or she is running a fever of 100 degrees or higher, and/or has one or more of the following symptoms: sore throat, body aches, vomiting or diarrhea, or extreme fatigue.
- Before sending your child back to school after an illness, make sure he or she is fever-free (without the use of a fever reducer, like Tylenol) for 24 hours.
- Clovis Unified will continue to conduct daily sanitation of bathrooms and high contact areas such as door knobs and countertops, but the best protection against colds and flu are the simple steps listed above.
